We must ask that all students are present every week in classes from now until the show.

We are sure you will appreciate that it becomes very difficult for teachers and students to progress with rehearsals if they continually have students missing. Mayhem students who are not in the show but would like to come along and support siblings or friends, can purchase tickets at a reduced rate of £10.00. **Members of Mayhem Passes (Gold and Platinum)** will be able to purchase the tickets 48 hours before at 12pm on **Wednesday 30th April**.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO PRE-ORDER YOUR PROGRAMME AT THE SAME TIME YOU PURCHASE YOUR TICKETS.

This helps us calculate how many programmes will need to be ordered for the show - we will only have a small amount to purchase on show day - once they're gone they're gone!

Please note: For Health and Safety reasons set by the Theatre, all children including 'babes in arms' have to be allocated a seat. Please also make it known at booking if you have a 'babes in arms' if under 1 years old. You will not be charged for this place but we will need to allocate a seat for you.

If you have any children under the age of 4 please purchase seats in the stalls only.

We cannot stress enough how important these rehearsals will be, and it is vital that everyone attends.

Please ensure they have plenty of snacks (NO NUTS) and drinks (Water only with a sports cap lid).

As all students have sections in both acts of the show there is no easy way to schedule the day other then in the full running order of the show so this will mean the students will have plenty of time to relax and eat between their sections and they will have indiviudal photos taken aswell by our photographers from 'Carmel Jane'.

SUNDAY 6TH JULY IMPORTANT SHOW DAY INFO:

It's showtime

<u>Please arrive at the Spotlight Theatre at the following times:</u>

Staff and Chaperones: 10.30 am All students arrive at 11:00 am

Please make sure your child has had a <u>big hot breakfast/ lunch</u> before they arrive. They will have plenty of opportunities for breaks throughout the day so please bring enough snacks/packed lunch and drinks with a sports cap lid in disposable bags.

Upon arrival at The Spotlight, you will need to sign in at the Mayhem desk located in the Spotlight Theatre Foyer.

You will also be told your child's group 'Colour' which you will need to know for pick up as they will be handed back to you at designated coloured collection points..

Once signed in, please make your way through the main entrance into the bar area and check the coloured signs into the auditorium so you know where your child is to be collected from after the show. Please take away with you any coats/jackets etc that your child may have worn to the theatre as there is not enough room backstage to accommodate these.

If you arrive too early, you will have to wait with your child until they are signed in. However, you must be in the foyer by the arrival time stated above. Please do not be late as this then causes disruption to the run of the day.

Unfortunately, parents are not allowed backstage or in the auditorium whilst rehearsals are taking place (unless they are chaperoning). We have very limited space and strict Health and Safety procedures. Should you have any problems whatsoever we can be contacted through the main reception desk.

AT THE END OF THE SHOW. STUDENTS WILL BE READY TO COLLECT FROM THEIR DESIGNATED COLOURED ZONE

The coloured zone procedure at pick up is **very important**. Please remember we have over 100 children backstage aged as young as 5yrs whom we need to move around the building safely. We kindly ask only **<u>1 parent</u>** is present at the designated colour to help students get to parents safely. Students will be brought out in groups depending on how long it takes them to change and pack away their belongings. Please ensure that you have sufficient time to wait. Unless there is a real emergency, students cannot be brought to you individually before the others in their group.

A detailed costume grid, outlining what each child will need to hire or supply, will be sent out via email in early May. This will tell you what you need to provide/buy or hire.

Payment

Please ensure all costume slips and payments have been submitted as soon as possible. All costume fees will be due by Saturday 31st May

On show day

All students should arrive in their first costume. All additional items of costumes that you have been asked to supply, should be brought on hangers with a large bag over the top of them/ suit bag all clearly labelled with their names on.

Please ensure every item is named, including shoes, socks etc. Please do not send your child with any valuables, mobile phones etc. Mayhem cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage t sonal property. Mayhem will bring all purchased or hired costumes to the theatre for the students and these will be given out in the dressing rooms.



Photography & Video

Audience and Photography Guidelines

The use of any recording devices during the show is strictly prohibited. It can distract performers and block the view for other audience members.

The show will be professionally filmed, and a free digital download will be sent to all families the week after the performance-courtesy of Mayhem. If you'd prefer a copy on a memory stick, these can be ordered for £8. Please email: millie@mayhemgroup.co.uk.

We kindly ask that audience members remain seated throughout the performance to avoid disrupting others and to ensure the best possible footage for the final video.

Backstage Photo Policy

Although we know students love capturing memories with friends, no photos are allowed backstage or on site during the show. This is to protect student privacy and ensure safeguarding, especially in shared dressing areas.

Instead, the Mayhem team will be capturing behind-the-scenes photos, which will be carefully managed and shared with families after the event.

Thank you for your support in helping us create a safe and respectful environment for all.

Food And Drink



Students must bring enough food and drink to last the entire day.

Drinks should be in plastic bottles with a sports cap top, which are less likely to get spilt.

Please place everything in a disposable plastic bag clearly marked with the child's name. The bags can then be binned after use.

Please do not use packed lunch boxes as they take up too much room.

Please no fizzy drinks or other items that could explode and make a horrible mess and strictly **<u>NO Nuts!</u>**

Start the day with a good breakfast/lunch! We will have water supplies throughout the day should the students need to fill up their bottles.



When chaperoning, please wear all black and comfortable shoes. Its always handy to have a small messenger bag to put clips, pins and a pen :-)

You will be given a lanyard on arrival which must be worn at all times.

Please don't forget , you MUST have your hard copy of your DBS on you at all times and you chaperone licence either printed or accessible on your phone in case of an inspection. This is mandatory for everyone on site at any given time.

A chaperone pack will be sent to you in the weeks leading up to the production which we will need everyone to read and sign before their chaperone duties. This is important and part of our risk assessment procedures.

A Note to all parents and Students

The staff at this production are volunteers who have given up their free time as they enjoy supporting and helping us. Children will be supervised at all times by licensed chaperones, Mayhem's parent volunteers and Mayhem staff members.

Please be assured that they will be well looked after for the duration of their time with us.

Once on site, they will not be allowed to leave the premises.
