Dear Parents and Students,

We hope you have all now been made aware of the change to our technical rehearsal date for our upcoming show "Vinyl to Viral." The rehearsal will now take place at the Spotlight Theatre on the evening of **Friday 3rd July**.

This is an extremely important technical run for the team working backstage, as well as for ensuring the show runs smoothly. It is vital that all students attend.

Please also ensure you:

- Join the private Facebook group, where Millie will post updates throughout the evening regarding collection times.
- Are clear on which classes and routines your child is involved in, so you know when to arrive and collect them.
- Understand that we will aim to dismiss students as early as possible to avoid a late evening, particularly for younger performers.

Running Order for the Evening

3:30pm – Registration (Younger Groups)

- Monday Pre-Primary Tap (Flintstones)
- Monday Pre-Primary Ballet (Cinderella)
- Saturday Pre-Primary Ballet (Wizard of Oz)
- Funky Pop Fridays (Golden)

These groups will begin with their on-stage run-through.

4:00pm – Registration (All Other Students)

- Students will be taken to dressing rooms upon arrival.
- We will then begin rehearsing the bows (finale), which is a detailed process involving over 200 students.

5:45pm (approx.)

- Younger students (3:30pm group) will be ready for collection after completing bows.
- Act 1 begins.
- Act 1 performers return to dressing rooms to prepare.
- Act 2-only performers may sit in the audience, watch Act 1, and eat.

Approx. 7:15pm

- Reset for Act 2
- Younger students may go home after Act 1 if they are not required in Act 2. Millie will update you via the Facebook group on this throughout the evening for pick up times.
- Remaining students will stay until the end.

What Students Need to Wear & Bring

For ALL students:

- Please all arrive in : Mayhem T-shirt, Black leggings, Plain black trainers (for bows/finale)
- Bag with all dance shoes
- Separate carrier bag named for food and drink (to avoid spills) and that can be thrown at the end of the evening - no lunch boxes, no nuts , sports bottle top waters only.

For Ballet, Tap, Lyrical, Modern, and Acro performers:

- Leotard and dance tights worn underneath T-shirt and leggings

Hair (all girls):

- Neat, tidy bun (show hair)

Additional items:

- Any personal props required for routines (bring to stage at the relevant time)
- Please keep belongings to a minimum

As we have now changed the date of our technical rehearsal, Millie will be contacting those who had previously offered to assist with the Saturday tech to see if you are available to support on Friday evening instead. Please keep an eye on your emails for further information.
